	FINANCIAL STATEMENT (sealed) *Downloaded statements are not acceptable Bank statement with official signature/seal must be submitted. It is important to show the Japanese immigration department that applicant has enough financial resources to stay for 10 months (for one semester only: 5 months). The fund must be evaluated in the actual currency that shows the equivalent amount of more than \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{1}\),600,000 (for one semester only: \(\frac{\pmathbf{8}}{8}\)00,000) in Japanese yen. In case the expense while in Japan will be partly or fully covered by any organizational fund, an official letter from the applicant's financial source should be attached. 	RECORD OF PREVIOUS JAPANESE STUDIES In case the applicant has no history of studying Japanese, choose the answer "no". Expected date of submission:
	PHYSICAL EXAMINATION RECORD Medical report must be filled completely. If some items are left blank, the reexamination of those items will be required before enrollment in Seinan Gakuin University Expected date of submission:

	CERTIFICATE OF PROFICIENCY IN ENGLISH (non-native speakers only) If the applicant's native language is another than English, it is required to submit a score of either TOEFL-PBT 550, TOEFL-iBT 79-80, or IELTS 6.0 to prove the proficiency in English. Expected date of submission:
