【Course Objectives and Focus:授業の到達目標及びテーマ】

This course is designed for JLPT N2 / N1 level students. It aims to develop a basic level of academic Japanese skills and knowledge about Japanese society and culture through direct experience, authentic materials and textbook.

【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

Activities:

<u>Data quest</u>: Students will look for data information about Fukuoka, the destinations of the planned city tour, and the destinations of the planned Saga and Nagasaki course trip. And they make some quiz questions. They will then make a quiz show.

<u>Visiting a Japanese family</u>: Students will learn about Japanese honorifics and manners for home visit, and practice them. After the visit, they will write a thanks letter by using Japanese forms.

<u>Japanese study</u>: Students will choose a subject about Japanese society. They will make an interview research and a documentation, and make a power point presentation.

Academic Japanese: Students will learn academic Japanese through textbook and course activities.

Numbers and statistics: Students will learn the system of numbers and use them through Japanese study.

Kanji words: Students will learn the system of kanji words and use them through Japanese study.

Katakana words: Students will learn the system of katakana words and use them through Japanese study.

■ "Tatewari" Activity (Inter-class activity):

Group work with students from other classes and with Japanese students.

Students will choose a topic of cultural difference between Japan and group members' countries, write a 5 minutes play in Japanese and play it.

Students will have homework every day: Preparation of presentations, writing / reading tasks, exercises, etc.
