Write some short essays. (Frequency and subjects will depend on class conditions.) 4. Prepare for their presentations. (Presentations will occur several times per semester. Frequency and subjects will depend on class conditions.) 5. Prepare for the Kanji and Kanji combinations' tests and exams.
