

## International Student Enrollment for 2017

This enrollment procedure is in place to accept international students who possess a strong desire to study at our institution.

### 1. Available Departments, Divisions, and Courses and the Number of Students Admitted

A few students may be accepted to any of the university's departments, divisions, and courses.

### 2. Applicant's Eligibility

Applicants must not be a Japanese citizen and must fulfill the criteria shown below to be eligible for this enrollment procedure.

- (1) **First Year Admissions** / Applicants must have completed or be scheduled to complete an education equivalent to 12 years of Japan's education system (six years of elementary school, three years of junior high school, and three years of senior high school). A minimum of eight years of education must have been completed at an educational institution outside of Japan.
- (2) **Third Year Transfer Students** / Applicants must have completed or be scheduled to complete an education equivalent to 14 years of Japan's education system (six years of elementary school, three years of junior high school, three years of senior high school, and two years of university). A minimum of ten years of education must have been completed at an educational institution outside of Japan. The applicant must have earned credits at their former university equivalent to our university's 62-credit transfer requirement.
- (3) **Third Year Entrance Students** / Applicants must have completed or be scheduled to complete an education equivalent to 14 years of Japan's education system (six years of elementary school, three years of junior high school, three years of senior high school, and a two year junior college, technical college, or specialized courses at a vocational school that fulfill the standards of Japan's Ministry of Education). A minimum of ten years of education must have been completed at an educational institution outside of Japan.
- (4) **Graduate School and Non-Degree Graduate Course Admissions** / Applicants must have completed or be scheduled to complete an education equivalent to 16 years of Japan's education system (six years of elementary school, three years of junior high school, three years of senior high school, and four years of university). A minimum of twelve years of education must have been completed at an educational institution outside of Japan.

(Note) Classes and lectures are taught in Japanese. The applicant must, therefore, possess the Japanese proficiency to take these classes.

### 3. Application Conditions

#### **Admissions for First Year Applicants (must fulfill conditions (1) and (2) shown below)**

(1) Applicants must have taken the Japan Student Services Organization's "Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU)" in or after June 2015 and received a **270 or higher** out of the maximum 450 in the "Japanese as a Foreign Language" section.

(2) Must fulfill one of the following:

a. Scored 420 or higher on the TOEFL®-PBT or scored 36 or higher on TOEFL-iBT (Excludes ITP)

※Applicants for the Division of English Literature and Division of Foreign Languages English Course must score 430 or higher on the TOEFL®-PBT or score 39 or higher on the TOEFL-iBT® (Excludes ITP)

b. Scored 370 or higher on the TOEIC® (Excludes IP)

※ Applicants for the Division of English Literature and Division of Foreign Languages English Course must score 400 or higher on the TOEIC® (Excludes IP)

※ Applicants are exempt from the above English language requirements if enrolled in International Division of Seinan Gakuin University, and his/her native language is English.

#### **Admissions for Third Year Transfer/Entrance, Graduate School and Non-Degree Graduate Course (one-year post-baccalaureate) Applicants**

(1) Applicants must have taken the Japan Student Services Organization's "Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU)" in or after June 2015 and received a **270 or higher** out of the maximum 450 in the "Japanese as a Foreign Language" section.

(2) **In addition to the above condition (1), students applying to departments, divisions, and courses other than the Department of Theology or the Department of Literature Division of Foreign Languages French Course, must fulfill one of the following conditions:**

##### **Department of Literature Division of Foreign Languages English Course**

a. Scored 550 or higher on the TOEFL®-PBT or scored 80 or higher on TOEFL-iBT (Excludes ITP)

b. Scored 800 or higher on the TOEIC® (Excludes IP)

c. Scored a 6.0 or higher on the IELTS

##### **Department of Literature Division of English Literature, Department of Commerce, Department of Economics, Department of Law, Department of Human Sciences, Department of Intercultural Studies**

a. Scored 500 or higher on the TOEFL®-PBT or scored 61 or higher on TOEFL-iBT (Excludes ITP)

b. Scored 650 or higher on the TOEIC® (Excludes IP)

c. Scored a 5.0 or higher on the IELTS

※ Applicants are exempt from the above English language requirements if enrolled in International Division of Seinan Gakuin University, and his/her native language is English.

#### **6. Examination Subjects, Scoring, and Time**

(1) First Year Applicants

● Written Examination

Essay written in Japanese (Scored out of 100 / 60 minute exam)

● Interview Examination

(2) Third Year Transfer/Entrance, Graduate School and Non-Degree Graduate Course (one-year post-baccalaureate) Applicants

● Written Examination

a. Foreign Language Examination (English for the Department of Theology and French for the Department of Literature Division of Foreign Languages French Course) (Scored out of 100 / 60 minute exam). Students applying to enroll in a department, division, or course other than the Department of Theology and Department of Literature Division of Foreign Languages French Course are exempt from the Foreign Language Examination.

b. Short essay written in Japanese in regards to the applicant's field of specialization. (Scored out of 100 / 60 minute exam) (The Division of English Literature and Division of Foreign Languages will write a short essay in Japanese)

● Interview Examination

#### **8. Enrollment Procedures**

The Enrollment Fee and Tuition Fees, etc. must be paid in full by 15:00 on December 16<sup>th</sup> (Fri.), 2016.

Should the student wish to pay the Enrollment Fee and Tuition Fees, etc. in separate installments, submit the required application for such procedures and pay the first installment (amount equivalent to the Enrollment Fee) by 15:00 on December 16<sup>th</sup> (Fri.), 2016 and the second installment (amount equivalent to Tuition Fees, etc.) by 15:00 on March 24<sup>th</sup> (Fri), 2017.
