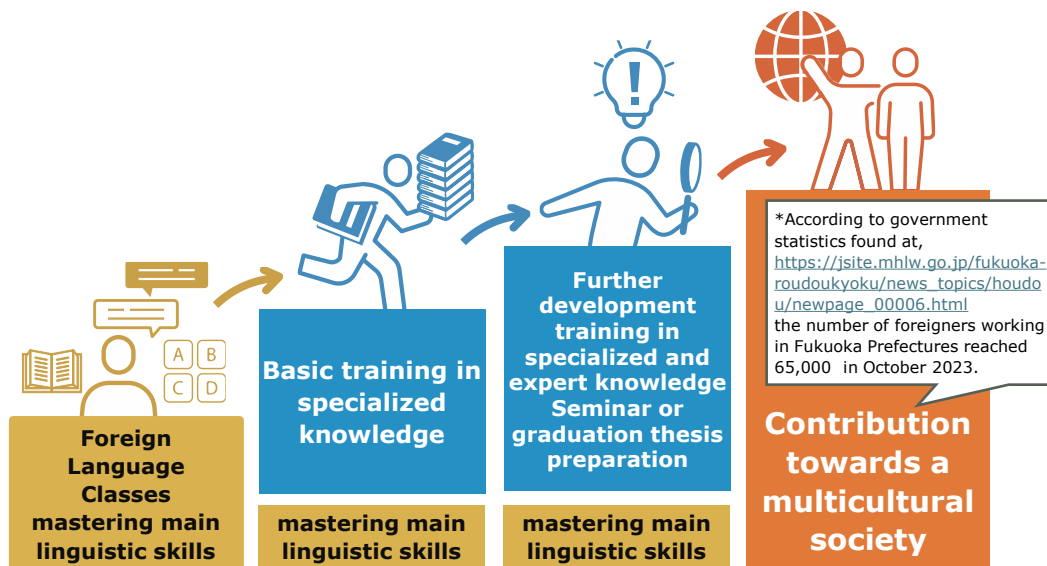
Foreign Languages – the essence and tools of lifelong learning

SEP candidates are selected on a merit base (e.g. GPA, English proficiency test scores, etc.). * Forty-seven out of ninety-two SEP participants are from the Faculty of Foreign Language Studies.
