<b>【Course Objectives and Focus: 授業の到達目標及びテーマ】</b>			
This course focuses on the history of foreign relations in the Edo period (1603-1868). During that time, Japan restricted exchanges with foreign countries, but some people visited Japan. They communicated with Japanese people in a limited environment and collected objects and information about Japan. This lecture aims to examine mainly on their collections and to understand Japanese culture and the influence of intercultural exchange on both sides in the Edo period.			
<b>【Course Summary: 授業の概要】</b>			
Among the people who collected historical materials about Japan, especially the collection of the Dutch factory employees and their writings are historical materials that offer a view of Japan in Europe at the time. There are many misunderstandings in their views of Japan. However, how they understood Japanese culture and Japanese people through comparison with their home country and other countries is an important external perspective to know Japan at that time. We will examine historical materials such as documents and pictures left in both Japan and Europe, and consider how the people of the Edo period lived, together with the social situation at that time.
