<b>【Course Objectives and Focus : 授業の到達目標及びテーマ】</b>			
This course will focus on basic Japanese sociolinguistics, especially modern speech styles of Japanese language. After successfully completing this course, students will acquire an ability to practice linguistic observation, in order to be able to continue their learning after the course is over, if they wish to do so. At the end of the term, they will write a short script by using what they have learned.			
<b>【Course Summary : 授業の概要】</b>			
1. Students will share the outcome of their preparation for the class themes. 2. The teacher will lecture about the class themes. 3. Students will discuss, do exercises, and analyze materials about the class themes.			
<b>【Preparatory Work : 準備学習等についての具体的な指示】</b>			
1. Students will prepare for each class at home (such as answering questionnaires about the class themes, looking for the meanings of keywords, reading articles or manga, analyzing them, etc.) 2. Students will prepare for their presentations. (Presentations will occur several times per semester. Frequency and subjects will depend on class conditions.) 3. At the end of the term, they will write a short script by using what they have learned.
