【Course Summary:授業の概要】

This class is designed for students who have learned the beginner's class. Intermediate Japanese III and Intermediate Japanese IV are continuous, and we aim to improve the four skills of reading, writing, speaking, and listening through both classes. The level of vocabulary and grammar used in class is about JLPT N3. We will cover familiar things such as conversations in student life, student experiences, and things that students are familiar with. At the end of this course, we will conduct an interview work with Japanese students. In class, we will emphasize communication between students and provide many opportunities to share their experiences, opinions, and knowledge.
