【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

This course is a Peer response-based advanced course that mainly aims to develop student's writing skills.

(1) In the former half of the course, students will learn basic rules for writing a composition and usage of grammar, paragraphs, function words, synonyms, punctuation marks and develop methods to widely utilize vocabulary and Kanji in line with the Advanced Japanese course III & IV.

(2) In the latter half of the course, students will develop skills in writing through discussions and magazine production project.

Students are required to review vocabulary and Kanji regarding that they have learned from the Advanced Japanese course III & IV for quizzes in the former half of the course.
