<b>【Course Summary: 授業の概要】</b>							
<p>This is a CLIL-based advanced Japanese course that mainly aims to develop students' listening, speech, and grammatical skills. Students will read the assigned text and/or watch the assigned video clip as preparation for each class. Students will have ample opportunities for group work, including discussions and group projects.</p> <p>(1) In the former half of the course, students will learn skills appropriate for speeches and dialogues by exchanging opinions in class.</p> <p>(2) In the latter half of the course, students will develop students' skills in researching, discussing and debating local and global issues more deeply.</p>
