<p>This class will be taught in conjunction with <b>【Japanese Reading A (IV)】</b>, using a Peer-response approach.</p> <p>(1) In the former half of the course, students will learn the basics and applications of everyday, practical composition for different situations, and learn how to use a wide range of vocabulary and develop their expressive skills.</p> <p>(2) In the latter half of the course, students will develop comprehensive writing skills in writing through discussions and magazine production project.</p> <p>※Classes are student-led, and therefore, the topics for discussion may change according to their needs.</p>
