P1. LPI study – An individual term project (40)

Each Student will conduct a National Logistics Performance study. This project requires students to learn the detail of LPI benchmarking methodology and conduct a data analysis using World Bank LPI database (http://lpi.worldbank.org/) to perform a targeted country's LPI benchmarking study. A 5-page or so WORD report and an XLS data analysis file must turn in through e-mailing to the instructor in the mid-semester for grading.

P2. Asian SC/L company case study – A group case study term project (50)

Students will be divided into several groups of 3 to 5 persons for this study. Each student group will select a global company of their choice and conduct a study regarding its penetration to the Asian market and the evolution, development and current challenges of its supply chain and logistics strategy and operations in Asia. It is suggested to make contact with Corporate HQ and Asian Regional HQ and Taiwan offices for possible interviews and data collections. Some recommendations regarding how the company should face the challenges in the future must be suggested. The study results will be presented by each group to the end of the semester. The presentation PPT file needs to be turned in after the presentation. The WORD report should be turned in no later than one week after the final week. The report page length should be limited to 20 pages. The report format and style is free for students to design by themselves.
