【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】							
After successfully completing this course, students will acquire competence in Japanese oral communication of pre-intermediate level. They will be able to understand, speak and discuss about familiar topics and specific domains of interest. At the end of the term, students will be asked to make a presentation by using what they have learned throughout the course.							
【Course Summary: 授業の概要】							
1. Quizzes about the previous lesson's content 2. Presentation of the day (one student per class) 3. Learning new words, grammars, expressions, skills, etc. 4. Exercises about the above 5. Creative activities: e.g. interview, discussion, speech, presentation, etc. ※Topics and domains for the creative activities are proposed by students and the instructor of the course. The instructor will invite guests for the activities.							
【Study Required outside Class (Preparation, etc.): 事前・事後学習】							
Students are expected to: 1. Prepare for the next lesson's content/activity. 2. Prepare for the quizzes regarding the previous lesson, by memorizing new words, grammars, expressions, etc. before every session. 3. Prepare for their presentations. (Presentations will occur several times per semester. Frequency and subjects will depend on class conditions.) 4. Prepare for the final activity and final exam of grammar and vocabulary ※A minimum of one hour should be spent on each of these daily preparations. Each student must also prepare for a presentation several times a semester. A minimum of one hour should be spent for the preparation of these presentations. A minimum of three hours should be spent for the preparation for final activity. A minimum of three hours should be spent for the preparation of the final exam.							
【Textbooks, Course Materials: 教科書、参考書等】							
In the beginning of the semester, students will buy exercise books of Japanese grammar and vocabulary that the instructor will choose after checking the level and the needs of the class. Additional materials will be handed out in class by the instructor.							
【Grading Criteria: 成績評価の方法】							
◆Daily quizzes: 20%, Preparation for each class: 10%, Presentation: 10%, Results of creative activities: 25%, Final presentation: 10%, Final exam: 25%. ◆Participation: -1% per missed class, lateness -0.1% per 10 minutes, inappropriate behavior -5% per notice. ◆Mark schemes may change slightly regarding class conditions. ◆Evaluation will be made according to students' levels of comprehension, achievement and competence in Japanese language. ◆A minimum of 80% attendance is required for the submission of the final presentation and taking the final exam. ◆Final presentation and final exam are mandatory for the credit.
