However, the resurgence of new directors and films in the late 1980s and 1990s once again focused the world's attention on Japanese cinema. This course is an introduction to contemporary Japanese films from the 1980s to present. By focusing on major directors, themes and genres, students will acquire the fundamentals of critical and technical language necessary to discuss and analyze films. The primary goal of this course is to understand the reinvention and transformation of contemporary Japanese cinema.
