【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

After successfully completing this course, students will acquire basic knowledge on various social issues prevalent in Japanese society. They will also acquire skills to analyze and understand the social issues addressed in manga and anime. At the end of the term, students will be asked to make a magazine based on what they have learned throughout this course.

【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

This semester, students will learn about various social and historical issues of Japan, mainly through Satoru Noda's *Golden Kamuy*. They will also learn about some specific subjects regarding manga/anime culture by visiting one or two museum exhibitions.

In class:

- 1. Students will share the outcome of their preparation activities
- 2. The teacher will lecture about the class content.
- 3. Students will discuss, complete exercises, and answer questionnaires about the class content.
- 4. Students will make a presentation about a specific content during the semester.

【Study Required outside Class (Preparation etc): 事前·事後学習】

Students are required to prepare for each class. Preparations include activities such as research, reading class subjects, consuming anime/films, reading manga, analysis, etc. A minimum of an hour should be spent on each of these preparations. Each student must also prepare for a presentation once a semester. A minimum of three hours should be spent for the preparation of these presentations.

This course is for students with previous knowledge of manga and anime, who read manga and/or watch anime on a regular basis. ◆Students must watch films and read manga required for the class. ◆Manga and anime well-known and acknowledged as major works in Japan will be mentioned in class as common knowledge. e.g. Naruto, Demon Slayer, Attack on Titan, films of Studio Ghibli and Makoto Shinkai, etc. ◆Students will also have to watch films and read manga in English in order to write and discuss them as well as give presentations in English. ◆ More detailed information about the course and the evaluation will be provided in class. ◆Course content may change regarding class conditions.
