【Course Summary: 授業の概要】							
<p>This course is designed for individuals who are continuing to enhance their Japanese skills. Students will further their ability to incorporate the fundamental structures and vocabulary acquired in prior semesters so that they can comprehend reading materials, express their opinions, and perform various communicative functions. Additionally, they will develop communicative skills that foster positive relationships with others. In this course, active participation is not only expected but required. Students will work on mini-projects within each chapter and at the conclusion of the course, they will select one of these mini-projects to further develop as their final project. Students are encouraged to take a proactive approach to their studies and to extend their learning beyond the assigned materials.</p>
