【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

This course aimed to gain overviews of the current and modern (the colonial empire of Japan) Japanese economic / social problems. Matters of Japanese economy are deeply affected by the particular cultural and historical backgrounds, which form special institutions. Based on the understandings of Japanese economy, we will discuss current issues in Japanese economy and society, and their possible future development. Also, aims to seek possible international partnership.

【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

Japan is very unique economic stat - the country developed as modern from the pure feudal state and soon joined to the countries seeking colonies for exploration in the late 19th. This class focuses on such historical experiences over Japan and its colonies and the impacts of Japan's colonial controls over the global economy and security. Now, the current Japan has suffered from the structural changes of economy and society for 30 years as known as "lost decades". In those period, economic and social conditions have been worsened and accordingly increased poverty, as the old institution remains in Japanese society and Japan has failed to accommodate itself to globalized market. Economic policies highly dependent on monetary easing apparently have failed to break the deadlock. Socio-economic aspects such as excessive muscular labour market based on life-long employment and old structure of market supports monopolistic structure of Japanese low-growth economy. This course also focuses on the worries amidly arise - aging society and social instability.
