### 【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

"The course objectives are to deepen your knowledge with regard to the meaning of kanji characters and usage of kanji vocabulary, and to acquire the ability to write kanji.

The goals of this course are:

- •To develop an interest in Kanji characters.
- •To be able to write simple sentences useful for daily life.
- •To be able to write 100 Kanji, and to be able to recognize 150 Kanji.

### 【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

Students will build upon their previous kanji study by learning an additional ~150 kanji over the course of the semester at a pace of one chapter (about 16 kanji) per class.

Students will learn mid-beginner meanings and reading of kanji, and practice understanding or writing sentences by using the new kanji.

It is necessary for students to study and memorize kanji in order to succeed with workbook assignments and weekly quizzes.

### 【Study Required outside Class (Preparation etc): 事前·事後学習】

Quizzes are given at the beginning of each class on the Kanji covered in the previous week's class.

As kanji requires self-study as well as class attendance, students must preview and review all class content regularly.
