【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

After successfully completing this course, students will acquire competence in Japanese language, especially in oral communication, of pre-intermediate level. They will be able to understand, speak, discuss and make presentations about familiar topics and specific domains of interest. Also they will be able to use basic Japanese honorifics in daily/academic/professional life. At the end of the term, students will be asked to make a presentation on their chosen subject about Japanese society/culture by using what they have learned throughout the course.

【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

- 1. Quizzes about the previous lesson's content
- 2. Presentation of the day (one student per class, five minutes per presentation)
- 3. Learning new words, grammars, expressions, skills, etc.
- 4. Exercises about the above
- 5. Creative activities: e.g. interview, discussion, speech, presentation, writing, reading, creating art works, etc.
- **Throughout the course, we will repeat the process of learning basic contents using textbooks/materials and applying them through creative activities. Topics and domains for the creative activities are proposed by students and the instructor of the course. The instructor will invite Japanese students for the activities.

【Study Required outside Class (Preparation, etc.): 事前·事後学習】

Students are expected to:

- 1. Prepare for the next lesson's content/activity.
- 2. Prepare for the quizzes regarding the previous lesson, by memorizing new words, grammars, expressions, etc. before every session.
- 3. Prepare for their presentations. (Presentations will occur several times per semester. Frequency and subjects will depend on class conditions.)
- 4. Prepare for the final presentation.
- *A minimum of one hour should be spent on each of these daily preparations. Each student must also prepare for a presentation several times a semester. A minimum of one hour should be spent for the preparation of these presentations. A minimum of five hours should be spent for the preparation for final presentation.
