【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

After successfully completing this course, students will acquire basic knowledge and Japanese proficiency on various cultural and historical issues prevalent in Japanese society. They will also acquire skills to analyze and understand the social, cultural and historical issues addressed in manga and anime in Japanese language. This course also emphasizes learning through experimental and creative activities.

### 【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

This semester, students will learn about various social, cultural and historical issues of Japan, mainly through Koyoharu Gotoge's *Demon Slayer: Kimetsu no Yaiba*. After reading every volume, students choose one or two subject(s) for their research and give one or two presentation(s) in Japanese. During the term, students will also be asked to copy/trace drawings of manga, to make a book bound in traditional Japanese style, to make a keychain with Japanese traditional patterns and Meiji-Taisho style Hiragana, Kuzushi-ji, and to do a voice over activity of manga/animated version. They will also learn about some specific subjects regarding manga/anime culture by visiting a museum exhibition.

## 【Study Required outside Class (Preparation etc.): 事前·事後学習】

Students are required to prepare for each class. At the beginning of the semester, students will read all 23 volumes of *Demon Slayer: Kimetsu no Yaiba* in English translation or in Japanese in the library. Each student must also prepare for a presentation once or twice a semester. A minimum of three hours should be spent for the preparation of one presentation. After some activities such as visiting exhibitions, the students are given the homework of writing a reflection on the activities in Japanese. It takes more than one hour.

This course is for students with previous knowledge and skills of reading manga, who read manga on a regular basis. ◆Students must read manga required for the class. ◆Manga and anime well-known and acknowledged as major works in Japan will be mentioned in class as common knowledge. e.g. *Naruto*, *Attack on Titan*, *Jujutsu Kaisen*, *Chainsaw Man*, films of Studio Ghibli and Makoto Shinkai, etc. ◆Students will participate in all activities of the course in Japanese and give their presentation(s) in Japanese. ◆More detailed information about the course and the evaluation will be provided in class. ◆Course content may change regarding class conditions. ◆Students will pay for transportation and admission fees to museum exhibitions (if necessary.)
