【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

By the end of this course, students will be able to:

- Use basic Japanese expressions and vocabulary in everyday situations.
- · Communicate simple ideas about themselves, their families, and their surroundings using Japanese.
- · Develop confidence in using Japanese in real-life settings such as shopping, dining, and navigating local areas.
- · Gain practical experience in listening to and speaking Japanese through interactive, task-based activities.

【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

This Introductory Level 1 class is designed for students who have never studied Japanese before, or who have less than six months of experience learning the language.

Unlike traditional language learning styles, this course offers an experiential approach, focusing on using Japanese in real-life situations. Students will step outside the classroom, use Japanese in actual settings, and enjoy experiencing the joy of actually being able to speak the language.

- · Japanese Language Treasure Hunt
- · Talking About Yourself and Your Family
- Shopping Challenge: "Go Buy OO!"
- · Mission: Try Japanese Cuisine in the Cafeteria
- · "Discover Fukuoka!" A Challenge-Based Stamp Rally
- "I'm a Journalist!" Writing a Report on Your Stay in Japan

Through these activities, students are also expected to gain a deeper understanding of Japanese culture.
