【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】								
To develop the following skills in written Japanese:								
1. Write more than 400 characters (three or more paragraphs) on familiar topics.								
2. Write sentences that readers will enjoy reading.								
 Compose polite and appropriate Japanese emails based on the recipient's role or relationship. Write Japanese content with a clear distinction between factual information and personal opinions. 								
5. Use about 350 kanji and learned expressions in an essay.								
6. Self-edit writing by noticing and correcting recurring mistakes in grammar and word usage.								
【Course Summary: 授業の概要】								
This class is designed for students who have completed the elementary Japanese class. Japanese Writing A (IV) and								
Japanese Reading A (IV) are continuous and we aim to improve reading and writing skills. The writing topics will include								
things such as e-mail and letters to close friends and superiors, places and things that you would like to recommend, and								
writing opinions on familiar social issues. Since this writing class is linked to the reading A (IV) class, the themes and								
content of the sentences in the reading material can serve as a model for writing. In class, before writing a sentence, the								
outline is created while talking about the topic with other students. After that writing rules will be introduced and practiced.								
Based on the outline and writing rules, students will write their essays for submission. To better use the grammar and								
vocabulary you had learned at the beginner level and to become more aware of common mistakes in your own writing, you will work in groups to identify common errors from compositions written by your classmates or yourself, and correct them								
together.

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【Note: 履修上の注意】

•The Kanji textbook, the writing textbook and the notebook attached to the textbook are required for each class. Bring them to class even if you don't think you will need them.

• If you are late to class more than 3 times it will count as one absence. Students are highly recommended to be seated 3 minutes before the class starts.

•Being more than 15 minutes late will count as one absence.

•Students who have 80% or lower attendance are not allowed to take exams. Exceptions for extended illness will only be made when written medical proof is provided.

• If a student uses their smartphone inappropriately, engages in activities unrelated to the class, or does not participate in class activities, they will be warned the first time. From the second time onward, it will be counted as an absence.

- Each unexcused absence will lower the overall course grade by 1%.
- No make-ups will be given for Kanji quizzes, but the lowest quiz score will be dropped.
- Make-ups will only be given for tests. Written medical proof is required.

• If a student cheats in any examinations (including quizzes) or plagiarizes required writing tasks, this student will receive a F as that final subject.

• All submissions, whether in draft or final form, to meet course requirements (including assignments and writing compositions) must be the student's own work. The use of either translation tools or AI tools for course assignments is the same as receiving assistance from another person. This goes against the fundamental requirement that all work must be the student's own and is strictly prohibited.
