【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

The goals of this course are for participants to: (1) become familiar with the characteristics of the Japanese economy across several topics, including demographic change, the labor market, the education system, public finance, and monetary policy; (2) gain insights into various economic and social problems that the Japanese economy has faced from an economic perspective; and (3) understand how the economy of their home country compares to the Japanese economy.

【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

This is an introductory course on the Japanese economy designed for beginning students. The instructor will provide an overview of each topic from both institutional and empirical perspectives at the beginning of each class, offering clear explanations to help students comprehend significant issues confronting the Japanese economy. In some sessions, the instructor will demonstrate how basic economic models can illustrate essential aspects of the Japanese economy. No advanced mathematics is required for this course, as it offers a wealth of verbal descriptions and extensive economic data regarding Japan, with a focus on demographic changes, labor markets, monetary policy, and fiscal policy. Additionally, students will learn how to obtain economic data and recognize the differences between their country's economy and Japan's.
