## 【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

This course aims to enhance students' understanding of Japanese culture, improve their proficiency, and develop their communication skills by engaging in activities such as exploring the city, experiencing local cuisine, interviewing residents, and immersing themselves in Japanese culture firsthand. Through these experiences, students will adapt to various circumstances, form connections with people, and gain a deeper understanding of authentic Japanese culture, while also developing the necessary vocabulary, expressions, and grammar. Students are encouraged to explore and interact with local residents and communities to fully grasp their culture, lifestyle, and mindset.

## 【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

There will be five main activities in this course. During each activity, students will collaborate with partners or group members and undertake missions such as finding, searching, and interviewing people. Prior to each activity, students will engage in preparatory sessions focused on learning or reviewing vocabulary, expressions, grammar patterns, functions, and cultural notes to ensure success. Following each activity, students will create presentations using tools like PowerPoint and video clips to share their findings and personal reflections. Active class participation is a requirement for this course.

\*Homework will be assigned daily, and students must complete it in order to participate fully in the following class session.
