【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】

This course is designed for JLPT N4 to N3 level students.

The goals of this course are:

- (1) To be able to develop their spoken Japanese skills while reviewing the vocabularies and grammatical expressions learned at the beginner level.
- (2) To be able to express one's opinion or feelings in Japanese in daily communication.
- (3) Comprehend authentic Japanese conversations and communicate better in various situations.
- (4) To develop students' skills to converse on and to do presentations on familiar issues and topics.

【Course Summary: 授業の概要】

Students will have opportunities to practice their language skills and experience the various culture through events and activities outside of class.

The following lessons will be covered in this class.

- Student-directed pair and small-group work.
- Review basic Japanese words and grammar.
