This course is designed for JLPT N2/N1 level students. It aims to develop an understanding of different styles of Japanese and to improve your ability to express yourself. The course focuses on experiencing the realities of contemporary Japanese society and culture through advertising Japanese around us not found in textbooks.			
【Course Summary: 授業の概要】			
Students will gain a deeper understanding of Japanese society and culture through authentic materials and interview activities with Japanese business people. They will also learn a wide range of expressive skills by studying different 'living' Japanese styles through researching advertisements. They will also be able to use the skills they have learnt to promote the attractions of their own country to the Japanese people in Japanese, and will have the opportunity to reflect on their own society and culture.
