By the end of this course, students will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use basic Japanese expressions and vocabulary in everyday situations.• Communicate simple ideas about themselves, their families, and their surroundings using Japanese.• Develop confidence in using Japanese in real-life settings such as shopping, dining, and navigating local areas.• Gain practical experience in listening to and speaking Japanese through interactive, task-based activities.• Demonstrate an introductory understanding of Japanese culture through hands-on experiences and reflection.• Work collaboratively with peers while engaging in language and cultural missions outside the classroom.			
【Course Summary: 授業の概要】			
This Introductory Level 1 class is designed for students who have never studied Japanese before, or who have less than six months of experience learning the language. Unlike traditional language learning styles, the Summer Course at Seinan Gakuin University offers an experiential approach, focusing on using Japanese in real-life situations. Students will step outside the classroom, use Japanese in actual settings, and enjoy experiencing the joy of actually being able to speak the language.
