【Course Objectives: 授業の到達目標】			
The goal of this course is to develop practical Japanese communication skills through participating in various social activities by using Japanese language. Especially students will learn and become accustomed to changing the speech styles depending on the situation and the person they are speaking to. In addition, through social activities, students will gain knowledge about the Japanese language, society and culture, sharpen their perspective on these issues, and acquire more advanced intercultural communication skills to become more contributing global citizens.			
【Course Summary: 授業の概要】			
Social activities are always carried out in class. First, in the preparation stage, students learn Japanese vocabulary, sentence patterns, and grammar, gather information, and organize it in a form that can be shared with others. In the main activities, students make presentations, participate in exchange activities, visit tours, observations, interviews, and research. In the post-activities, students share the results, reflect on them, and review the linguistic knowledge.			
【Study Required outside Class (Preparation etc.): 事前・事後学習】			
Review should take at least one hour each day, and preparation should take at least one hour each day. The time spent depends on the content, the students' Japanese level, and their learning ability. Review involves memorizing and practicing new vocabulary, sentence patterns, and grammar learned in class. Preparation involves preparing the content for presentations and activities in the next class.
